### Type of presentation:

**Poster presentation.** The abstract will be presented in poster format. Posters will be on view throughout the meeting. Only limited boards are available and abstracts for posters will be accepted, after approval by the Scientific Committee, on a first come first served basis.

**Short oral presentation\*** This option is reserved for PhD students and young postdocs presenting an abstract as first author. Six abstracts will be selected for oral presentation (10 min) in the Session dedicated to the Young Participant Award on Sunday June 24. Abstracts which are not selected will automatically be re-considered as posters.

\* Authors will be notified at the end of March as to whether their abstract has been accepted or not for oral presentation. Winners of the Young Participant Competition will be awarded a complimentary registration pass for the conference.

### Important information

Each author can submit only one abstract. Abstract presenters must register and pay their registration fees by March 30. Authors submitting their abstract for the Young Participant Award will be notified whether they have to pay or not after the selection has been made. If payment is not made by the deadline date, the abstract will be automatically withdrawn and will not appear in the Book of Abstracts.
