A postdoctoral position is available in the laboratory of Dr. Catarina M. Quinzii, at the H. Houston Merritt Clinical Research Center for the study of Neuromuscular Disorders, in the Department of Neurology, at Columbia University Medical Center, New York, NY.

The postdoc will be involved in a Department of Defense funded project focused on understanding the role of sulfides metabolism impairment, and its contribution to oxidative stress, in mitochondrial diseases, by using a variety of biochemical and molecular approaches in *in vitro* and *in vivo* models of mitochondrial diseases.

We are seeking highly motivated, enthusiastic and autonomous postdoctoral researchers with laboratory experience related to human genetics or disease mechanisms, able to work independently, and with others. Background in mitochondrial pathology, and experience with mice and tissue culture are assets but not requirements.
